“True Worship”
Isaiah 6
Rev. Yuen-Who Voon

Worship is not merely music. Job 1:20 ***“Then Job arose, tore his robe and shaved his head; and he fell to the ground and worshipped.”***

I. True worship is having the eyes to see God. (v. 1-4)

“In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, high and lifted up, and the train of His robe filled the temple. (2) Above it stood seraphim; each one had six wings: with two he covered his face, with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. (3) And one cried to another and said: “Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts; The whole earth is full of His glory!” (4) And the posts of the door were shaken by the voice of him who cried out, and the house was filled with smoke.”

II. True worship is having the lips that confess. (v. 5-7)

“So I said: “Woe is me, for I am undone! Because I am a man of unclean lips, And I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; For my eyes have seen the King, The LORD of hosts.” (6) Then one of the seraphim flew to me, having in his hand a live coal which he had taken with the tongs from the altar. (7) And he touched my mouth with it, and said: “Behold, this has touched your lips; Your iniquity is taken away, and your sin purged.”

God changes the man before He makes him a messenger.

The message of change must first change the messenger.

III. True worship is having the feet to go. (v. 8-13)

“Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying: “Whom shall I send, And who will go for Us?” Then I said, “Here am I! Send me.” (9) And He said, “Go, and tell this people: ‘Keep on hearing, but do not understand; Keep on seeing, but do not perceive.’

(10) "Make the heart of this people dull, And their ears heavy, And shut their eyes; Lest they see with their eyes, And hear with their ears, And understand with their heart, And return and be healed." (11) Then I said, "Lord, how long?" And He answered: "Until the cities are laid waste and without inhabitant, The houses are without a man, The land is utterly desolate, (12) The LORD has removed men far away, And the forsaken places are many in the midst of the land. (13) But yet a tenth will be in it, And will return and be for consuming, As a terebinth tree or as an oak, Whose stump remains when it is cut down. So the holy seed shall be its stump."

Rom 10:15 "And how shall they preach unless they are sent? As it is written: "HOW BEAUTIFUL ARE THE FEET OF THOSE WHO PREACH THE GOSPEL OF PEACE, WHO BRING GLAD TIDINGS OF GOOD THINGS!"

Eph 6:15 "and having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace;
