Public Debate Among Supporters of all-Russian Unity and Advocates of Decolonization and De-Imperialization "Free Russia" VS. PostRussian Independent States: After Putin or After Russia?

*Debate Format:

Each side (3—5 debaters) has 10 minutes for an opening speech, 10 minutes for questions and answers from opponents, and 10 minutes for questions and answers from guests and the jury. Then, the opposing side debates according to the same format, after which the jury gives 1 to 10 points for the round to each party (if desired — with a laconic comment). There are three rounds, after which the jury and the moderator summarize the debate results.

Each round lasts one hour and are devoted to:

- 1. Global peace, international relations and collective security architecture.
- 2. Political system (national, ethnic, regional and religious aspects) and social stability.
- 3. Economic & trade components.



^{*}The jury is an International Council consisting of 5 speakers from the US, EU and Ukraine.
