

Dis & Dat

Margarita Pie

4 T. margarine

1 ¼ C. coarsely crushed unsalted pretzels

1 can (6 oz.) frozen concentrated limeade

1 can (6 oz.) water

3 eggs, separated (so they don't fight)

2 envelopes unflavored gelatin

3 T. tequila (or more if you're going to take a nip)

2 T. triple sec liqueur

Green food coloring (optional)

Fresh lime slices and/or crushed pretzels

Microwave margarine in a 9-in. microwave proof pie plate on high for 1 minute or until melted. Stir in pretzel crumbs. Press evenly over bottom and sides of dish. Microwave on high $1 \frac{1}{2}$ to 2 minutes and set aside.

Combine limeade, water, egg yolks and gelatin in a 2-qt. microwave proof bowl or casserole; whisk together. Microwave on high 4 minutes, whisking or stirring twice. Stir in tequila, triple sec and green food coloring. (Take another nip of the set aside tequila.)

Place in freezer for 45 minutes or until thickened. Beat egg whites until they're senseless or until they form stiff peaks. Fold in limeade mixture and turn into prepared pie shell. Chill until firm. Garnish top

with lime slices and/or crushed pretzels, if desired. Serves 8.
