BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The above Claims for Refund of Tax Payment were received by the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors during the period of September 7, 2010 to September 21, 2010. The claims are being referred to County Counsel for processing.

Upon the receipt of a recommendation to approve or deny the claims from the office to which the claims are referred, and the concurrence of County Counsel in that recommended action, County Counsel will bring the claims back to the Board with a recommendation to either approve or deny the claims. In the event the office to which the claims are referred reports that the issue underlying the claims has been resolved, County Counsel will prepare a report to the Board advising it of this fact.
