Cable Knit Scarf





SCARF

Finished Size: 7"w x 60"l

MATERIALS

Bulky Weight Yarn:

Red - 5 ounces, (140 grams, 225 yards)

Blue - 3 ounces, (90 grams, 135 yards)

Straight knitting needles, size 9 (5.50 mm) **or** size needed for gauge

Cable needle

Bobbin

GAUGE: In Stockinette Stitch, 16 sts and 21 rows = 4"

STITCH GUIDE

FRONT CABLE (uses next 3 sts)

Slip next st onto cable needle and hold in **front** of work, K2 from left needle, K1 from cable needle.

BACK CABLE (uses next 3 sts)

Slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and hold in **back** of work, K1 from left needle, K2 from cable needle.

Note: Wind bobbin with Red. Always keep the bobbin on the **wrong** side of the Scarf. When changing colors, always pick up the new color from **beneath** the dropped yarn and keep the color which has just been worked to the left **(Fig. 1, below)**.

With Red, cast on 33 sts loosely.

Row 1: K1, (P1, K1) across.

Row 2: P1, (K1, P1) across.

Rows 3-6: Repeat Rows 1 and 2, twice.

Row 7 (Right side): (K1, P1) twice, with Blue K 25, with Red bobbin (P1, K1) twice.

Row 8: (P1, K1) twice, with Blue P 25, with Red (K1, P1) twice.

Row 9: (K1, P1) twice, K5, (slip 1 as if to **knit**, K3) 5 times, (P1, K1) twice.

Row 10: (P1, K1) twice, (P3, slip 1 as if to **knit**) 5 times, P5, (K1, P1) twice.

Row 11: (K1, P1) twice, with Blue K3, work Back Cable, (K1, work Back Cable) 4 times, K3, with Red (P1, K1) twice.

Row 12: (P1, K1) twice, with Blue P 25, with Red (K1, P1) twice.

Row 13: (K1, P1) twice, K1, (slip 1 as if to **purl**, K3) 6 times, (P1, K1) twice.

Row 14: (P1, K1) twice, (P3, slip 1 as if to **purl**) 6 times, P1, (K1, P1) twice.

Row 15: (K1, P1) twice, with Blue K1, (work Front Cable, K1) 6 times, with Red (P1, K1) twice.

Repeat Rows 8-15 until Scarf measures approximately 59" from cast on edge, ending by working Row 12.

Last 6 Rows: Repeat Rows 1-6.

Bind off all sts **loosely** in ribbing

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS ABBREVIATIONS

K knit
mm millimeters
P purl
st(s) stitch(es)
tog together
YO yarn over

★ — work instructions following ★ as many more times as indicated in addition to the first time.

† to † — work all instructions from first † to second † **as many** times as specified.

() or [] — work enclosed instructions as many times as specified by the number immediately following or work all enclosed instructions in the stitch indicated or contains explanatory remarks.


colon (:) — the number(s) given after a colon at the end of a row or round denote(s) the number of stitches you should have on that row or round.

work even — work without increasing or decreasing in the established pattern.

CHANGING COLORS

When changing colors, always pick up the new color yarn from **beneath** the dropped yarn and keep the color which has just been worked to the left of the new yarn *(Fig. 1)*. This will prevent holes in the finished piece. Take extra care to keep your tension even.
