Cable Twirl Afghan

Finished Size: 45" x 60" (114.5 cm x 152.5 cm)

MATERIALS

Medium Weight Yarn:
39 ounces, 2,455 yards (1,110 grams,
2,245 meters)
29" (73.5 cm) Circular knitting needles, size 17
(12.75 mm) **or** size needed for gauge
Cable needle

Note: Afghan is worked holding two strands of yarn together.

GAUGE: In Stockinette Stitch, 9 sts and 12 rows = 4" (10 cm)

STITCH GUIDE

CABLE (uses 6 sts)

Slip next 2 stitches onto cable needle and hold in **back** of work, K1 from left needle, K2 from cable needle, slip next stitch onto cable needle and hold in **front** of work, K2 from left needle, K1 from cable needle.

AFGHAN

Cast on 116 sts.

Rows 1-5: Knit across.

Row 6 (Right side): K5, P1, K6, P1, ★ work Cable, P1, K6, P1; repeat from ★ across to last 5 sts, K5.

Row 7: K6, P6, (K1, P6) across to last 6 sts, K6.

Row 8: K5, P1, K6, P1, ★ work Cable, P1, K6, P1;

repeat from ★ across to last 5 sts, K5.

Row 9: K6, P6, (K1, P6) across to last 6 sts, K6.

Row 10: K5, P1, K6, P1, ★ work Cable, P1, K6, P1; repeat from ★ across to last 5 sts, K5.

Row 11: K6, P6, (K1, P6) across to last 6 sts, K6.

Row 12: K5, P1, work Cable, P1, ★ K6, P1, work Cable, P1; repeat from ★ across to last 5 sts, K5.

Row 13: K6, P6, (K1, P6) across to last 6 sts, K6.

Row 14: K5, P1, work Cable, P1, ★ K6, P1, work Cable, P1; repeat from ★ across to last 5 sts, K5.

Row 15: K6, P6, (K1, P6) across to last 6 sts, K6.

Row 16: K5, P1, work Cable, P1, ★ K6, P1, work Cable, P1; repeat from ★ across to last 5 sts, K5.

Row 17: K6, P6, (K1, P6) across to last 6 sts, K6.

Repeat Rows 6-17 for pattern until Afghan measures approximately 58" (147.5 cm) from cast on edge, ending by working Row 10.

Last 5 Rows: Knit across.

Bind off all sts.
