**DAY 29 // OCTOBER 25**

**ONE** Pray for peace and contentment.

**TWO** Pray for God to provide for all of Menlo Church's financial needs.

**THREE** Pray for our mission partner: Downtown Streets Team and their commitment to end homelessness by restoring dignity and rebuilding the lives of unhoused men and women.

**DAY 30 // OCTOBER 26**

*The words of the reckless pierce like swords, but the tongue of the wise brings healing. Truthful lips endure forever, but a lying tongue lasts only a moment. PROVERBS 12:18-19*

**ONE** Pray for your words to bring healing to someone you encounter today.

**TWO** Pray for the Menlo Church Staff who take care of all of our facilities.

**THREE** Pray for our mission partner: Ecumenical Hunger Program. EHP provides compassionate, dignified and practical assistance to families and individuals experiencing economic and personal hardship. They offer material help, support services, and advocacy for our neighbors in need.

**DAY 31 // OCTOBER 27**

*God says: "Is not this the kind of fasting I have chosen: to loose the chains of injustice and untie the cords of the yoke, to set the oppressed free and break every yoke? Is it not to share your food with the hungry and to provide the poor wanderer with shelter—when you see the naked, to clothe them, and not to turn away from your own flesh and blood? ISAIAH 58:6-7*

**ONE** Ask God to show you how you can extend his love to the oppressed, poor and homeless.

**TWO** Pray for Menlo Church to care for the oppressed and marginalized in our world.

**THREE** Pray for our mission partner: Familia Cristiana Verbo, a local Hispanic church serving the Redwood City community.

**DAY 32 // OCTOBER 28**

*The earth is the Lord's, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it; for he founded it on the seas and established it on the waters. PSALM 24:1-2*



**ONE** Pray for your community and those in your local government.

**TWO** Pray for God to be preparing a Lead Pastor for Menlo Church in his timing.

**THREE** Pray for our mission partner: Family Supportive Housing as they provide temporary housing and targeted support to single and two-parent families who are experiencing homelessness.

### DAY 33 // OCTOBER 29

*Walk with the wise and become wise, for a companion of fools suffers harm. PROVERBS 13:20*

**ONE** Pray for God to give you good friends. Thank him for the ones you have.

**TWO** Pray for the Menlo Church Groups staff and Life Group leaders.

**THREE** Pray for our mission partner: Freedom House. Their mission is to bring hope, restoration and a new life to the survivors of human trafficking by providing long-term, holistic care.

### DAY 34 // OCTOBER 30

**ONE** Pray for love.

**TWO** Pray for Menlo Church to make disciples marked by love for God and others.

**THREE** Pray for our mission partner: Generations United. GU empowers the children and families of North Fair Oaks & Redwood City to reach their full potential through building relationships that equip them to succeed.

### DAY 35 // OCTOBER 31

**ONE** Pray for God's guidance for your day.

**TWO** Pray for the elders (session) of Menlo Church.
