**DAY 36 // NOVEMBER 1**

*It is a sin to despise one's neighbor, but blessed is the one who is kind to the needy.*  
**PROVERBS 14:21**

- ONE** Pray for your neighbors today.
- TWO** Pray for Menlo Church to be kind to the needy and serve the communities around each of our campuses.
- THREE** Pray for our mission partner: Hillcrest Chaplaincy and Ministry of San Mateo. They provide incarcerated young men and women (teens) with the love, joy, hope and peace that can only be found in a life-bringing relationship with Jesus, through Faith-based Counseling, Bible Study and Sunday Worship Services.

**DAY 37 // NOVEMBER 2**

*Also, seek the peace and prosperity of the city to which I have carried you into exile. Pray to the Lord for it, because if it prospers, you too will prosper.* **JEREMIAH 29:7**

- ONE** Pray for our nation as we prepare to vote tomorrow.
- TWO** Pray for God to provide volunteers and leaders for Menlo Kids.
- THREE** Pray for our mission partner: Lifemoves. They are dedicated to eradicating homelessness in Silicon Valley by providing temporary shelter and intensive customized case management.

**DAY 38 // NOVEMBER 3**

*I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people—for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. This is good, and pleases God our Savior, who wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth.* **1 TIMOTHY 2:1-4**

- ONE** Pray for our nation as we vote today.
- TWO** Pray for Menlo Church to be a community that is kind when they disagree with one another.
- THREE** Pray for our mission partner: Live in Peace as they empower youth at risk of dropping out of school along with young adults. They use a highly relational model that connects young people to their talents, educational pathways, jobs, and a bright future.

**DAY 39 // NOVEMBER 4**

*Jesus said: "I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing.* **JOHN 15:5**

- ONE** Pray for love.



**TWO** Pray for God to provide volunteers and leaders for Menlo Church's Student Ministry.

**THREE** Pray for our mission partner: New Creation Home Ministries. They are a two-year transitional housing program for at-risk pregnant women and girls (13-24 years old) who are homeless due to trauma (domestic violence, gang violence, substance abuse, and poverty). They also offer weekly Lifeskills/Parenting classes for their residents and the surrounding community.

## DAY 40 // NOVEMBER 5

*The Lord is my light and my salvation—whom shall I fear?*

*The Lord is the stronghold of my life—of whom shall I be afraid?* PSALM 27:1

**ONE** Pray for joy.

**TWO** Pray for the Preaching Team at Menlo Church.

**THREE** Pray for our mission partner: Oak Grove Christian Ministries as they support Christ-centered organizations and related Christian activities based in the Bay Area. One of those ministries is Career Action Ministries, a ministry that specializes in helping people during job transition.

## DAY 41 // NOVEMBER 6

*Whoever is patient has great understanding, but one who is quick-tempered displays folly. A heart at peace gives life to the body, but envy rots the bones.* PROVERBS 14:29-30

**ONE** Pray for peace.

**TWO** Pray for God to provide Life Group Leaders for Menlo Church.

**THREE** Pray for our mission partner: Project WeHope. They aim to help people become healthy, employed, and housed using innovative solutions.

## DAY 42 // NOVEMBER 7
