

Church on the Hill Worship Order and Reflection Guide

Sunday, March 1, 2026

Pray:

Lord Jesus,

You are the One who crosses boundaries, who sits beside our wells, who speaks to us in the heat of the day. You meet us in our thirst, in our shame, and in our searching.

Today, we come empty and thirsty. Unable to do what we feel called and desire to do, but we come to You. Draw near to us again.

Give us living water. Transform us from the inside out.

As we seek to live fully surrendered and ALL IN for Your purposes, shape us into people who reflect Your grace and truth. This we ask in the name of the One who sees us, knows us, and loves us, Jesus, the Christ, we pray.

Amen.

Read Scripture: Read John 4:1-41 (NLT)

As you read the passage, notice the following:

- Where Jesus intentionally moves toward someone others avoided
- The repeated theme of thirst and living water
- The moment the woman leaves her water jar behind
- The shift from isolation to witness

Afterwards, pause and sit quietly for one minute.

Respond: *Lord Jesus,*

Thank You for Your Word that meets us at the well. Thank You that it speaks truth into our thirst, light into our shame, and hope into our dry places. Through Your Word, You remind us that we were made for more, and real transformation begins when we surrender fully to You.

As we commit ourselves to being ALL IN for the work You are doing in us and through us, let what we read and hear today take root and rise like living water within us.

In the name of the Father and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Word: Watch the sermon here [<https://onthehill.life/sermon/transformational-power/>]. As you listen, reflect on the following statement: “The living water of Jesus not only refreshes you; it transforms you.”

Reflect: What “wells” do I keep returning to rather than experiencing the living water that Jesus provides? What “jar” do I need to leave behind?

What area of my life am I currently dissatisfied with? What might transformation in Jesus look like for me in relation to that concern?

The woman at the well left her jar and ran back to the village, telling everyone, “Come and see a man who told me everything I ever did! Could he possibly be the Messiah?” In what ways does your life share the same message, through words and actions: “Come and See!”?

If being ALL IN begins with surrender and leads to witness, how is Jesus inviting me to move from receiving to sharing?

Benediction

May you go into this new week no longer drawing from wells that leave you empty, but filled with the living water of Christ that changes you from the inside out.

Go as people who are ALL IN for the transforming work of Jesus, inviting others to come and see and to Love God and Love People.
