May God continue to bless you, enlarge your spiritual life, and expand His Kingdom as you seek Him first!



MATTHEW 6:9-10

Lord, may your kingdom come to my neighborhood, my school, my place of employment, and my church. Remove any obstacles to your will and move in powerful ways that are disproportionate to who we are and who I am. Come, Holy Spirit. Thy Kingdom come. Amen.



MATTHEW 4:16

PRAYER:

Lord, let your light shine so that those who do not know you will come to saving faith. Let the light of the Gospel shine forth from my life, my family's life, in my school, business, and throughout my church. Release the captives. Open blind eyes. Thy Kingdom Come. Amen.

ACTS 5:14-15
