- Key Scripture: Matthew 6:19-21

- Focus: Honoring God with resources Key #4

Month 8: Sharing Your Faith

- Theme: Being Christ's Witness
- Key Scripture: Acts 1:8
- Focus: Evangelism and discipleship.

 - Leading a group and creating a curriculum plan

Month 9: Holiness and Obedience

- Theme: Pursuing God's Will
- Key Scripture: 1 Peter 1:15-16
- Focus: Living a life set apart for Christ.
 - Key #2
 - Personal discipleship curriculum plan

- Theme: Rejoicing in God's Faithfulness
- Key Scripture: Psalm 126:3
- Focus: Reflecting on growth and giving God glory.
