BIG IDEA

When we invite Jesus to overcome the power of sin in our lives, He is faithful and will do it. But if we simply stop with the eradication of sin, those places in our life will inevitably become filled in with something else. Filling our life with the pursuit of Jesus is the only way to prevent sin and pride from overtaking us.

Who am I?

Based on this passage, what do we learn about ourselves? What do we need to know about who we are in relationship to who God is and what He has done?

How should I live?

In light of what this passage tells us about God, what He has done, and who we are, how then should we live? What things do we need to repent of? What do we need to take to heart? Where do we need to trust God?
