The Preston Trail Connect Group Residency is a leadership residency in the area of shepherding and formation of Connect Groups at Preston Trail Community Church in the areas of men, women and/or couples.

V. SPECIFIC RESIDENT DUTIES

Adopt the Preston Trail mission statement and ministry strategy.

Prepare for and attend meetings and events as required:

- a. Weekly four-hour Residency Class with a rigorous curriculum of reading, sermon reviews and discussion
- b. Weekly or bi-weekly one-on-one meeting with ministry supervisor for the purposes of both mentorship and discipleship
- c. Monthly all-staff meetings



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Attend training conferences including the Global Leadership Summit, RightNow Media Conference and others as scheduled.

Participate in weekly self-evaluations, monthly supervisor evaluations, and quarterly program evaluations.

VI. SPECIFIC MINISTRY DUTIES

Prepare for and attend all meetings and events as required.

Under the direction of the Groups Pastor:

- a. Work to develop ministry processes as needed.
- b. Execute the vision for groups ministry as defined by Preston Trail's senior leadership and align group leaders to that vision.
- c. Implement the integration of Preston Trail ministry strategies.

Under the direction of the Men's, Women's or Couples' Director:

- a. Form new Connect Groups from short-term group environments.
- b. Oversee the successful launch of new Connect Groups and integration of new members from Group Connect and other on-ramp opportunities.
- c. Recruit, select and train Connect Group leaders and coaches.
- d. Assist and evaluate curriculum and teaching planning.
