III. GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The Preston Trail Student Ministry Residency is a leadership residency in the areas of development and shepherding various facets of the student ministry at Preston Trail Community Church.

IV. GENERAL LEADERSHIP GOALS

Discern and clarify your calling toward kingdom work and be better equipped to fulfill that calling.

Work proactively and independently with the ability to deliver high-quality output in a fast-paced environment.

Learn how to recruit, develop and lead a volunteer team.

Learn how to create and manage ministry needs including budget, ministry events calendar, and administrative duties.

Develop as a fully devoted follower of Jesus committed to and growing in the areas of self-leadership, organizational leadership, church leadership and thought leadership.

V. SPECIFIC RESIDENT DUTIES

Adopt the Preston Trail mission statement and ministry strategy

Prepare for and Attend Meetings and Events as Required:

- a. Weekly four-hour Residency Class with a rigorous curriculum of reading, sermon reviews and discussion
- b. Weekly or bi-weekly one-on-one meeting with ministry supervisor for the purposes of both mentorship and discipleship
- c. Monthly all-staff meetings



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- d. Attend training conferences including the Global Leadership Summit, RightNow Media Conference and others as scheduled.
- e. Participate in weekly self-evaluations, monthly supervisor evaluations, and quarterly program evaluations

VI. SPECIFIC MINISTRY DUTIES

Prepare for and attend all meetings and events as required:

- a. Weekly team meetings for weekend services, projects and upcoming events
- b. Co-lead bi-monthly intern and programming meetings
- c. Teaching team meetings

Under the direction of the Family Ministry Pastor:

- a. Build, lead and schedule the “Fun Squad” for weekend services that will assist set up and tear down of weekend services, build connections with students between services, and develop a rhythm of at least one additional/different fun option each month.
- b. Develop and implement volunteers as needed, “Fun Squad”, and moments for mid-week service.
- c. Prepare and deliver a message at at least three gatherings by the end of residency.
- d. Assist in the onboarding and acclimation of Student Ministry interns.
- e. Serve as a small group leader.
