The Technical Arts Residency is a leadership residency in the areas of lighting, sound, and other technical needs that serve the worship environments at Preston Trail Community Church.

V. SPECIFIC RESIDENT DUTIES

Adopt the Preston Trail mission statement and ministry strategy

Prepare for and attend meetings and events as required

a. Weekly four-hour Residency Class with a rigorous curriculum of reading, sermon reviews and discussion



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- b. Weekly or bi-weekly one-on-one meeting with ministry supervisor for the purposes of both mentorship and discipleship
- c. Monthly all-staff meetings

Attend training conferences including the Global Leadership Summit, Right Now Media Conference and others as scheduled.

Participate in weekly self-evaluations, monthly supervisor evaluations, and quarterly program evaluations.

Prepare for and attend all meetings as required:

- a. Weekly production meetings for weekend services
- b. Weekly team meetings to discuss projects and upcoming events
- c. Weekly tech meeting for final weekend service information

- Learn the philosophy of decision making within the technical production team
- Grow in knowledge and implementation of the following production technologies:
 - o Live Sound- digital audio consoles
 - o Live Video- multicamera, iMag, broadcast
 - o Lighting- conventional, LED, intelligent
 - o Media presentation and projection- ProPresenter
- Assist with the process of designing, installing, and troubleshooting technical systems (audio, video, lighting, presentation, projection)
- Work on set construction and installation for weekend services or events
