

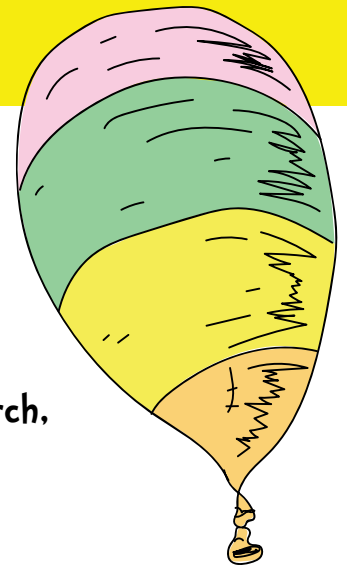

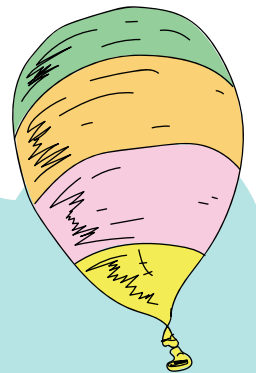

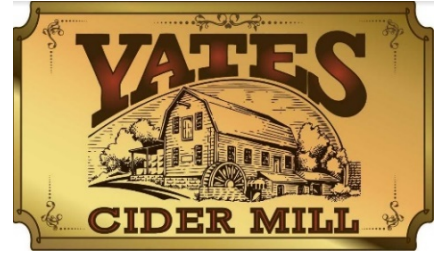
Be sure to stop by the Unshackled booth and put your name in the hat to be entered in a drawing for door prizes!



# Race Reminders

1. Be sure to **cross the street** to the Orion Township building to reach the start line at your designated time.
2. Make sure to attach your bib number in a visible place on the front of your shirt.
3. Those checking in Friday do not need to check in again Saturday. Proceed directly to the starting line at Orion Township building!
4. Lost and found area is at the Registration Tent.
5. First-Aid will be located in a Medical Tent.
6. Always pass on the left side. Please be considerate of the other runners and move over to the right if you are running at a slower pace or walking.
6. Safety first! There are a few **road crossings** that volunteers will be helping racers cross. Even with help, all racers should look for traffic before crossing streets or driveways.
8. Alcohol is not permitted on the race site.
9. Race registrations are non-transferable and non-refundable.

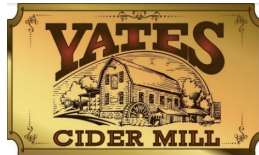

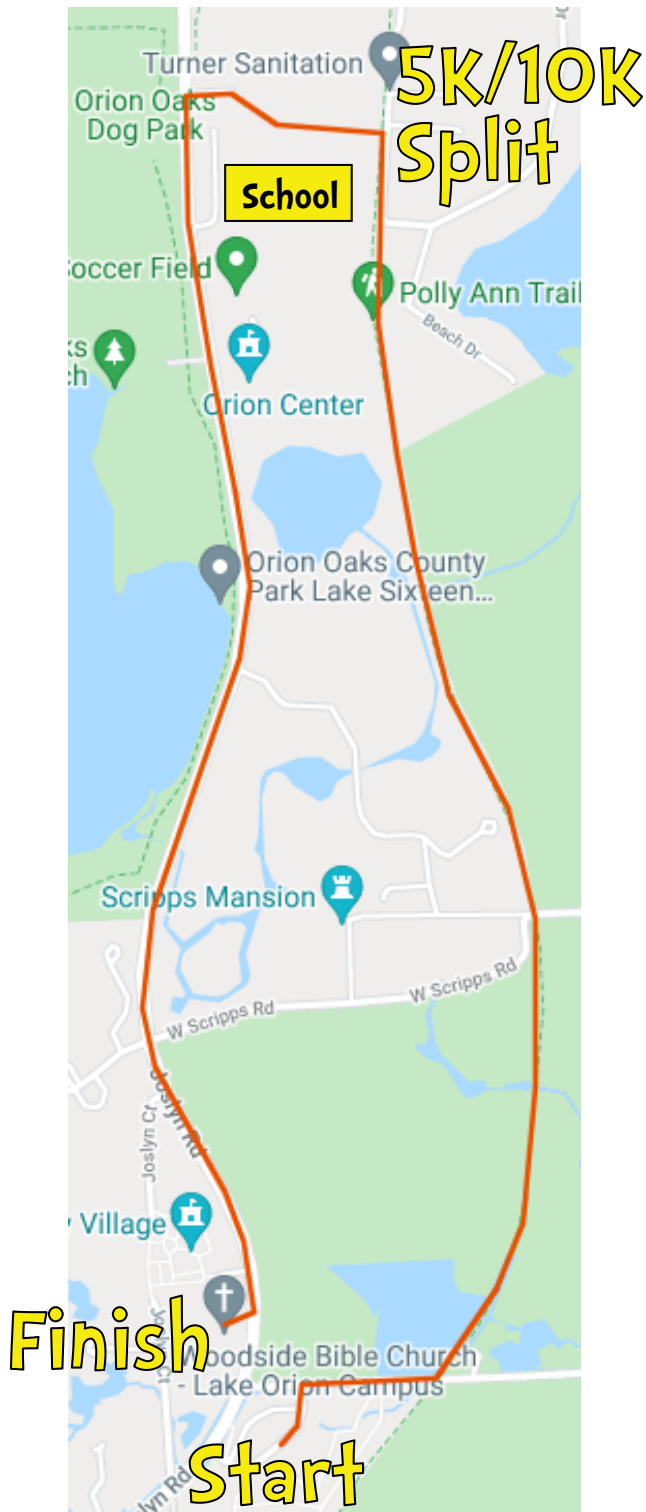
# Racecourse Map

The starting line for the **5K & 10K** is in the parking lot behind the Orion Township building. The race will exit the parking lot and head **NORTH** to Greenshield Dr. At Greenshield Dr. the race will turn **EAST** and head toward the Polly Ann Trail. At the Polly Ann Trail the race will turn **NORTH**. At Orion Oaks Elementary School the **5K** race will turn **WEST** following the trails behind the school to cross Joslyn Rd (a police officer assisted crossing). After crossing Joslyn Rd. the **5K** turns **SOUTH** and continues along the bike trail until the finish line at Woodside Bible Church, Lake Orion.

The **10K** race continues past Orion Oaks Elementary School along the Polly Ann Trail for another 1.55 Miles. The Polly Ann Trail crosses Clarkston Rd., then crosses Joslyn Rd. and turns **EAST**. The race follows the Polly Ann trail across Joslyn Rd. again, continuing **NORTH** until the turn-around. The **10K** then returns on the same path to Orion Oaks Elementary School, and follows the 5K course back to the finish at Woodside Bible Church, Lake Orion.
