It's a "cluckin'" good run!

Mag nail 6" from concrete curb and 48' 2" west of west edge of storm drain west of crosswalk

Mile1: East edge of FRT 32' north of line extending from center of Gazebo

Mile 2: East edge of path 15' south of south edge of electrical transmission tower just south of S curve in trail

Mile 3: East edge of sidewalk at 224 north Bennett, 57' 6" south of fire hydrant

Mag nail center of FRT even with concrete expansion joint for center of Gazebo Turn:

West edge of FRT 70' northwest of fire hydrant at Bennett Street 5k:

Mile 4: West edge of FRT south of water treatment plant, 13' north of gray MHC north of bridge over creek Mile 5: West edge of FRT 25' north of "Bioswale" sign north of intersecting path

Mile 6: West edge of FRT at 250 address, 67' 6" north of 1st lamp post south of 250 address


Finish: Mag nail 6" from concrete curb, even with 2nd street light west of Island Avenue

This course was measured using the full width of the road and the Shortest Possible Route (SPR)


Note Restriction: The out and back segment from the Rte 38 underpass to the turnaround in Bennett Park was measured always in the right lane. Cones and marshals required at the blind turns for safety.


