

The 2015 growing season began 2-3 weeks earlier than usual with warm weather conditions in the winter that continued throughout spring and summer. Yet, light scattered showers in late August and a return to normalcy in September gave a break to what was an intense growing season. The result was concentrated, balanced fruit. This was one of the earliest harvest on record. The fruit came in without flaw. The fermenters hummed along at a classic pace finishing off with what was to be an exceptional vintage.

2015 60 Souls is a beautiful snapshot of the 2015 vintage, with both power and structure giving this wine immediate appeal yet ability to be cellared for several years. Layers of red cherries, plums & spicy earth fill the nose. The fruit, tannins and acid all come together to make the wine complete.
