APPEARANCE

A beautiful pale pink hue with amber glints reminiscent of the color of apricots, enhanced by discreet, pearly bubbles and incomparable finesse.

AROMAS

Intensely perfumed, the complex nose immediately announces a powerful, structured Rosé wine. The Pinots Noirs, vinified as still red (8% of the blend) give the wine a particular aroma – similar to that which comes from a simmering pot of bubbling strawberry jam, candied fruit mingled with cinnamon, cardamom, along with honey and praline.

FLAVORS

A true journey through flavor, the palate revels in the creamy sensation of juicy plums. This wine is characterized by a silky texture reminiscent of fig pie, pine nuts, and sweet pastries. Spicier notes of liquorish and cumin then come into play followed by a warm, round finish marked by notes of blackberry tea, cherries, pink peppercorns, and fresh figs

60% Pinot Noir, 32% Chardonnay, 8% complementary red varieties

AGING

More than 7 years on lees
