TASTING NOTES

The nose is elegant and fresh, with floral notes and red fruits. The mouth has rich acidity, accompanied by raspberries that brings a great persistence that stands out.

TASTING NOTES

Fresh. Delicate bouquet with notes of red fruit, flowers, and citrus fruit. Nice balance between sweetness and acidity. Fresh fruit, and great length.

Very pale pink color. Aromas of fresh and citrus fruit. Fleishy palate of citrus and white flowers. Long finish with salinity.

• The wine carries the appellation "Les Vins de Méditerranée Indication Géographique Protégée" which allows the Perrin family to select the best fruits from the southeast of France.

APPELLATION	Côtes du Rhône, France
VARIETAL BLEND	Cinsault, Grenache, Mourvèdre, Syrah
TASTING NOTES	Attractive notes of red fruit and citrus fruit (bergamot, grapefruit) and a lot of freshness. Fresh and fruity palate.



SELLING POINTS	• Each of the Famille Perrin Crus wines is unique, using organic and biodynamic approaches, mastering the art of blending and bringing out the freshness of the Southern Rhône aromas.

APPELLATION	Etna, Italy
VARIETAL BLEND	Nerello Mascalese, Nerello Cappuccio
TASTING NOTES	Sour cherry, pomegranate, acacia honey. Complex, fresh, and with an intense and well-balanced acidity. Persistent finish.



SELLING POINTS	• A striking raspberry-hued rosé made from the traditional Etna varieties grown on volcanic soils.

VARIETAL BLEND	Malbec, Pinot Noir
TASTING NOTES	Zingy lime flavors with crisp acidity.



SELLING POINTS	• Sourced from some of the best high altitude vineyards of Argentina.

VINTAGE	NV
APPELLATION	Loire Valley, France
VARIETAL BLEND	100% Cabernet Franc
TASTING NOTES	Pale pink in color with aromas of fresh strawberry and raspberry. On the palate, lovely freshness and a hint of licorice, typical of the Cab Franc.



SELLING POINTS	• The estate received the natural wine certification, Vin Méthode Nature in 2020.
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Champagne Delamotte Brut

APPELLATION	Le Mesnil-sur-Oger,, France
VARIETAL BLEND	Pinot Noir: 80%, Chardonnay: 20%
TASTING NOTES	A very refined, somewhat smoky wine. Some say that it is what dreams are made of.



SELLING POINTS	• Produced by the fifth oldest Champagne house from grapes grown in 100% Grand Cru vineyards using the traditional saignée method.

TASTING NOTES	Seductive raspberry hints and fine exquisite bubbles. Fresh red fruit. Perfect balance.



SELLING POINTS	• Produced using Famille Perrin's revolutionary new sparkling wine process, the Méthode Contemporaine.

Crémant de Bourgogne (12x750ml)

VINTAGE	NV
APPELLATION	Burgundy, France
VARIETAL BLEND	100% Pinot Noir
TASTING NOTES	The nose is expressive with notes of red fruits. The rich and full palate (aromas of ripe apricots, redcurrants and raspberries) maintains all of its finesse. Intense and refined.



SELLING POINTS	• Vinified in the traditional Champagne method from pure Pinot Noir.
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Fleur de Miraval

VINTAGE	NV
APPELLATION	Champagne, France
VARIETAL BLEND	100% Pinot Noir
TASTING NOTES	There are floral notes of acacia, which are quickly followed by red currant and peach. As the wine opens up, notes of lightly toasted pastries appear. In the mouth, almond and frangipane are subtly entwined to recall the great Chardonnays of the Sixties, bolstered by hints of candied orange peel.



SELLING POINTS	• Each bottle is lacquered so that the wine is never exposed to light until the day the bottle is opened.
