ABOUT TAHUAN

Founded by fourth-generation winemaker Ernesto Catena, Tahuan is a winery based in Mendoza, Argentina. Tahuan produces 100% varietal wines from selected old vineyards at the foothills of the Andes Mountains. Over the years, Ernesto and his team designed their biodynamic farm and vineyard as a sculpture to be gazed upon from the sky, much like the cities of the Mayan and Incan civilizations. Tahuan draws its name and inspiration from Tahuantinsuyu, the name the Incas used to refer to their empire.



THE WINE

- Tahuan Cabernet Sauvignon is produced with **100% Cabernet Sauvignon** grapes from Mendoza, Argentina.
- Intense spicy aromas of raspberry jam and hints of paprika.
- The crisp acidity is in harmony with round tannins, and well-integrated oak is expressed in vanilla and chocolate flavors.
- A rich, warm complexity ends in a long, unctuous finish that invites you to take another sip.
