About TintoNegro

TintoNegro is the project of two long-time friends and colleagues based in Argentina's largest winegrowing area, Mendoza. Here, the Malbec grape thrives in the hot, dry climate. Specializing in Malbec, TintoNegro means "black wine" in Spanish, celebrating the essence of this rich, concentrated, dark grape. Each TintoNegro wine comes from a different part of Mendoza, showcasing the region's stylistic diversity.

The Wine

- TintoNegro Uco Valley Cabernet Franc is made with **100% Cabernet Franc** grapes and showcases intense floral aromas and mineral flavors.
- Perfumed violet aromatics, bright red fruit flavors, supple texture, and a bright, chalky-mineral finish.
- At the foot of the Andes mountains, Uco Valley is a high elevation and cool area within Mendoza where Malbec is primarily grown. Other grape varieties like Cabernet Franc also flourish here.
