Specializing in Malbec, TintoNegro means "black wine" in Spanish, celebrating the essence of this rich, concentrated, dark grape. The Wine

- TintoNegro Finca La Escuela Malbec is made with **100% Malbec** grapes in Argentina.
- · Firm tannins, intense and deep red fruit flavors, oaky notes with butter and leather. Savory, saucy berry and plum flavors.
- · Finca La Escuela is named for the rural school located on the vineyard property in Altamira, Mendoza. TintoNegro supports the school through regular donations and scholarships.
