ABOUT MARQUÉS DE CÁCERES

Marqués de Cáceres is one of Rioja's preeminent wineries established in 1970 and led today by Cristina Forner. Located in the North of Spain, Rioja is among Spain's best-known wine regions and is loved for its age-worthy red wines with plush red fruit, great structure, and tannin.

Leading the movement known as the "Rioja Renaissance", Marqués de Cáceres revolutionized winemaking in Spain in the 1970's.

THE WINE



A limited production wine, Excellens Rosé is made from a blend of red grapes grown in the Rioja region: **60% Garnacha Tinta and 40% Tempranillo**.



This wine has a pale rose color and a fresh, juicy, delicate character.



Aromas of rose petals and peaches lead to a silky-smooth palate with flavors of ripe white peaches and pears.
