ABOUT CAPARZO

The history of Caparzo dates back to the end of the 1960s, when a group of friends purchased an old ruin with vineyards at Montalcino in Tuscany in central Italy. The farm estate was renovated, modernized, and new vineyards were planted. In 1998, Elisabetta Gnudi Angelini purchased Caparzo. Today, Elisabetta with her son, Igino, and daughter, Alessandra, carry out their objective: to combine tradition with innovation to create a high-quality wine that is the expression of an excellent terroir. With vineyards on all sides of the hill of Montalcino, Caparzo produces a range of wines.

THE WINE

- Caparzo is a historic Brunello producer, one of the first in Montalcino
- 100% Sangiovese grapes from vineyards across the appellation
- Ample and complex with echoes of wild berry fruit
- Dry, warm, and persistent with an aging capacity of more than 30 years!
- Pairs beautifully with roasts, grilled and braised meats, aged cheeses
