In northeastern Italy, there is a group of hills known as Collio, where Gradis'ciutta can be found. Before it was named Gradis'ciutta, the vineyard was known as Mosvini, which means “Mount of Wine” in Latin. Living up to its original name, today the area is synonymous with high-quality white wines. At Gradis'ciutta, Collio's unique terroir is reflected in the outstanding wines produced—both indigenous and international varietals. A family-owned winery, all of their winemaking practices embody a deep care and respect for the land.

THE WINE

- 100% Sauvignon, a French vine cultivated originally in Bordeaux
- Intense and delicate, with hints of elderberry, pepperoni and sage, with exotic notes of pineapple
- Very fresh
- Serve with antipasti, prosciutto, non-meat risotto, souffle, and baked vegetables
