ABOUT DOMAINE DELAPORTE

Located in the heart of the Sancerre region in France, Domaine Delaporte has been passed from father to son since the 17th century. Today, under the youngest generation's leadership, Domaine Delaporte practices sustainable and biodynamic methods, such as eliminating the use of pesticides in the vineyards. Sancerre is one of France's best-loved wine regions, celebrated for crisp, aromatic whites made from Sauvignon Blanc grapes and high-quality goat cheese.

THE WINE

- Best known for white wines, Sancerre also has small plantings of red Pinot Noir grapes. Domaine Delaporte Sancerre Silex Rouge is produced with 100% Pinot Noir grapes from Sancerre.
- The name Silex translates from French to "flint" and refers to the soil in which the grapes are grown.
- A beautiful ruby-crimson color. Intense roasted, grilled, and toasted aromas on the nose.
- Round, unctuous, and full-bodied, the wine has soft and silky tannins and offers flavors including caramel and fruit compote.
