About Château de la Ragotière

Château de la Ragotière is housed in a beautiful 14th-century French castle in the Loire Valley, where today the old chapel has been repurposed as a tasting room. Château de la Ragotière is a reference-point producer of Muscadet, the most famous style of wine from the Western side of the Loire Valley, recognized for light-body, citrus and mineral flavors, and crisp acidity. Certified sustainable by Terra Vitis, Château de la Ragotière crafts the finest examples of refreshing and complex Muscadet wines only 30 miles from the Atlantic Ocean.

The Wine

- Château de la Ragotière Muscadet Sèvre et Maine Sur Lie Vielles Vignes is made from 100% Melon de Bourgogne grapes grown on old vines in the Sèvre et Maine subzone.
- Concentrated ripe fruit, lemon, intense acidity, and a lively, fresh aftertaste.
- This wine undergoes 100% malolactic fermentation which provides a creamy, rounded texture.
- This crisp, refreshing wine is a great match for scallops, lobster, grilled fish, Asian food, and goat cheese.
