ABOUT DOMAINE & MAISON LES ALEXANDRINS


Domaine & Maison Les Alexandrins is an esteemed winery located on the steep slopes of the Northern Rhône Valley of France. This region is best known for deep-flavored, long-lived red wines made from the Syrah grape, and is equally admired for aromatic, full-bodied white wines from Viognier, Marsanne, and Roussanne grapes.

A collaboration between three friends, Maison Les Alexandrins offers contemporary, delicious, and varied expressions of the Northern Rhône Valley.

THE WINE

- Crozes-Hermitage is a village in the Northern Rhône Valley which produces predominantly red wines.
- Maison Les Alexandrins Crozes-Hermitage is made from 100% Syrah, the only red grape that is permitted in the Crozes-Hermitage appellation.
- Fruit-forward and voluptuous with aromas of red fruit, pepper, smoke, and vanilla on the nose.
- On the palate, morello cherries, licorice, and violet. A perfect match for grilled foods.
