ABOUT KARA TARA

Kara Tara is a joint venture between 2018 Diners Club Young Winemaker of the Year Rüdger van Wyk and José Condé of Stark-Condé Wine. The name "Kara-Tara" refers to the Karatara river that runs through the small town on the Cape South Coast of South Africa, where Rüdger grew up. Translated from Khoisan, the language of the first people of South Africa, it means "deep dark shadows."

THE WINE

- 100% Pinot Noir
- The grapes are sourced from vineyards in the Elgin region, about an hour east of Cape Town
- Elegant, lightly-wooded style with classic strawberry and red cherry notes with a hint of spice
- Silky-smooth, firm tannin structure that supports the bright fruit notes of the wine
