Quickly becoming leaders of the California Rhône movement, Tablas Creek started importing vine cuttings from the Southern Rhône, building a grapevine nursery, and creating an estate vineyard from the ground up. Today, the vineyards at Tablas Creek are proudly biodynamic and organic certified by Demeter USA.

THE WINE

-  Tablas Creek Patelin de Tablas Rosé is a blend of **76% Grenache**, **19% Mourvèdre**, and **5% Counoise** grapes from Paso Robles, California.
-  Light peach color. On the nose, spicy aromas of nectarine, mandarin, sea spray, and crushed rock.
-  Flavors of yellow raspberry and blood orange with mouthwatering acidity and a long finish.
-  Delicious match for salmon, sushi, anchovies, sausages, fried chicken, and Mediterranean tapas.
