- Style: Medium tannins, acid and dry finish
- Appearance: Soft purple
- Aromas: Raspberry, blueberry, tobacco leaf
- Flavors: Dried cherries, cranberries, vanilla







#### Estate Cab. Sauv.

- Estate Grow: 150 acres at Clos LaChance
- Style: Medium body and tannin, light acid
- Appearance: Garnet
- Aromas: Plum, blackberry, green pepper
- Flavors: Fresh blueberries, white pepper, plum








### Hayes Valley Sauv. Blanc

- Style: Dry, high acidity, crisp
- Appearance: Light straw
- Aromas: Grapefruit, lemon, honeysuckle
- Flavors: Apricot, citrus, honeydew melon








### Hayes Valley Chardonnay

• Flavors: Chocolate, currants, black olives








# Hayes Valley Zinfandel

- Appearance: Garnet
- Aromas: Raspberry, oak, cinnamon
- Flavors: Dark plums, clove, graphite







# Hayes Valley Cab. Sauv.

- Hayes Valley: Historical Grape Growing Region
- Style: Full body, medium acid, high tannins
- Appearance: Dark currant
- Aromas: Tobacco, star of anise, huckleberry
- Flavors: Cedar, bay leaf, blackberry








# 22 Pirates

- 22 recognized Rhône varietals in the US
- 22 Pirates on the label
- Label done by French artist
- Artwork 1<sup>st</sup> published in London Newspaper in 1855
- Style: Heavy body, medium tannins and long finish
- Appearance: Dark ruby
- Aromas: Milk chocolate truffle, caramel and baking spice
- Flavors: Dark plum and blackberry











### Colibri Rosé

- Colibri: French for Hummingbird
- Style: Dry Rosé
- Appearance: Salmon color
- Aromas: Watermelon, strawberry and lemon
- Flavors: Rhubarb, honeydew and citrus zest





#### Colibri White

- Colibri: French for Hummingbird
- Style: Light body with medium acidity
- Appearance: Straw
- Aromas: Pineapple with minerality
- Flavors: Pineapple, Citrus and Pink Grapefruit
