VICTOIRE

Late harvested from a selection of the best parcels of Gros & Petit Manseng grapes, this sweet white wine has then further been matured in historic 420L Allier & Vosges barrels. Showcasing a bright and light acidic character, consistent with the other wines of the Arton Domaine, this blend is notable for utilizing two unique regional varietals that yield acidity yet stunning complexity as a late harvest offering.

Nose: Granny Smith Apple, Honey, Lime Peel, Almonds, and Marzipan.

Palate: Balanced sweetness with bright acidity. Undertones of vanilla and roasted coffee punctuated by lime and tropical fruits that finishes exceptionally clean.
