

WARLANDER



Warlander blends three- and four-year old Kentucky Straight Rye and Bourbon whiskeys, melding the fruit forward and baking spice notes of Kentucky Straight Rye with the depth and spice of High-Rye Kentucky Straight Bourbon. The result is a bold, layered, and intentional blend. Created by the multi-award-winning team at High n' Wicked, this special release is finished with original artwork by artist and pro skier, **CHRIS BENCHETLER**. Like the whiskey, his design is raw, refined, and fearless. Wild in spirit like the horse it's named for, Warlander honors tradition while breaking through it.



ON NOSE & AROMA:

Bright citrus, grapefruit, and lemon zest, evolving into caramelized orange and a hint of salted caramel. There is a potent baking spice note - layers of cinnamon and a bit of allspice, but ultimately, this leans very bright and citrus forward with a hint of green apple, grilled peaches, and fresh Dill. With a very subtle black cherry on the back.

PALATE:

On the palate: this is bold and expressive, extremely layered and a very full palate experience, lots of caramel and lush savory notes, Dark chocolate, cocoa nibs, Cherries and blackberries, with black pepper and allspice on the back end.

THE PROCESS

This particular blend was conceived after a number of trial and error blind tastings alongside bartenders, distillers, blenders, and Spirits experts - as having the greatest complexity and ultimately showing more character than the individual elements themselves. A sum greater than its parts.

After marrying, the whiskey was rebarreled in a combination of its own ex-bourbon and ex-rye casks and allowed to rest for just over two months. This stage encouraged deeper integration of flavor. Afterward, it was slowly proofed down to 99 proof, a proof point selected through additional blind tastings to best showcase the whiskey's full complexity and balance.

This approach combines the vibrant, orchard-fruit-forward profile of rye—think pears, apples, and bright spice—with the berry-rich sweetness and caramel depth of a high-rye Kentucky bourbon. Each category brings its strengths, but together they create something truly distinctive.
