## Investment in a Quality Christian Education

## Financial Assistance

We understand that many families are in the difficult position of weighing the life-changing value of providing a Christian education for their child with the affordability of tuition within their budget. If you desire a Christian education for your child, then we will strive to work with you to make that a reality.

### Tuition

**K-8th Grade Tuition:** \$6,400/per student

**Registration Fee:** \$100/per student

(Non-Refundable)

**Tech Fee:** \$100/per student (K-8th only)

### Indiana Choice Scholarship

The State of Indiana provides a tuition payment for eligible families who are enrolled at St. John Lutheran School by August 1st. The amount of the scholarship is based on your income and household size as well as the school district where you reside.

### Lutheran SGO Scholarships

These scholarships are available for families that do not qualify for the Indiana Choice Scholarships. They are income based. These scholarships are available because of the generous donors who value a Christian education. These scholarships serve as a pathway to the Choice Scholarship.

### Eagle Scholarships through St. John Lutheran Church

Eagle Scholarships are available for families with students in Kindergarten through 8th grade who attend St. John Lutheran Church worship services 60% or more of the time. These scholarships are supported by the generous ministry efforts of St. John Lutheran Church and School. A form requesting participation in this program must be completed and turned in to be considered for scholarship program. These scholarships may be up to \$2,300 for the first child and up to \$3,200 for additional siblings.
