FOR THOSE WHO WISH TO COMMUNE

In care for those desiring communion at our altar for the first time, we ask that you speak with Pastor prior to Communion.

- Holy Communion is the true body and blood of our Lord Jesus Christ, under the bread and wine, for us Christians to eat and to drink, instituted by Christ Himself.
- Our Lord has instructed us to examine ourselves before participating in this meal (1 Corinthians 11:23-32).
- In preparation for the sacrament, you should ask yourself the following questions:
  - Am I a sinner, and am I sorry for my sins?
  - Do I believe that Jesus Christ is my Lord and Savior?
  - Do I believe that Christ gives me His body and blood together with the bread and wine for the forgiveness of my sins?
  - Will I try, with God's help, to amend my sinful life?

**Restoration Celebration:** Don't forget to join us this weekend to see the completed exterior work on the Sanctuary. You will have an opportunity to see before and after pictures and take a stroll around the building. We can't wait to see you on Saturday after the 4:30 service, on Sunday between 9:15 and 10:30 am and after the 10:45 service. Snacks will be provided as well.
