— Pumpkin Sales Co-Coordinator Fall 2017 — Weekly Organizer Sept. 29 – October 29 — Unload pumpkins from truck September 27	Manage overall volunteer recruiting, logistics and promotion or be a weekly organizer and manage shifts and remind volunteers for one week during the sale (2-3 hours required)
— Pizza Sales January 7 – February 4	Sunday morning shadow chairs of this fundraiser. We'll also make pizzas on Feb 3rd!
— Car Wash Co-Coordinator June 17	Manage overall volunteer recruiting, logistics and promotion.

— Hospitality Team	Greet youth and parents on one Sunday/month.
— Prayer Team	Pray for youth and their prayer requests. May be done individually.
— College Student Support	Help purchase and assemble care packages 3 times a year.
— Office Support	Assist with databases, mailings, etc. (2-3 hours per week or month.)
— Lodge Caretakers	Special projects around Lodge, inside and out such as painting, gardening, organizing kitchen, etc. (Not routine cleaning.)
