

SPIRITUAL GIFT DESCRIPTIONS

- A) ADMINISTRATION** - The gift of administration is the divine strength or ability to organize multiple tasks and groups of people to accomplish these tasks. Luke 14:28-30; Acts 6:1-7; 1 Corinthians 12:28
(Admin, Kids Check-in, Creative, Missions, Production, Portable, Set Up/Tear Down)
- B) CRAFTSMANSHIP** - The gift of craftsmanship is the divine strength or ability to plan, build and work with your hands in construction environments to accomplish multiple ministry applications. Exodus 30:22, 31:3-11; 2 Chronicles 34:9-13; Acts 18:2-3 (Kids, Students, Facilities Team, Missions, Production, Setup/Teardown)
- C) EVANGELISM** - The gift of evangelism is the divine strength or ability to help non-Christians take the necessary steps to becoming Christ followers. Acts 8:5-6, 8:26-40, 14:21, 21:8; Ephesians 4:11-14 *(Groups, Students, Prayer)*
- D) EXHORTATION** - The gift of exhortation is the divine strength or ability to encourage others through the written or spoken word and Biblical truth. Acts 14:22; Romans 12:8; 1 Timothy 4:13; Hebrews 10:24-25
(Groups, Kids, Students, Greeters, Next Steps, Kids Check-in, Parking, Host Team)
- E) FAITH** - The gift of faith is the divine strength or ability to believe in God for unseen supernatural results in every arena of life. Acts 11:22-24; Romans 4:18-21; 1 Corinthians 12:9; Hebrews 11 *(All Teams)*
- F) GIVING** - The gift of giving is the divine strength or ability to produce wealth and to give by tithes and offerings for the purpose of advancing the Kingdom of God on earth. Mark 12:41-44; Romans 12:8; 2 Corinthians 8:1-7, 9:2-7
(Legacy)
- G) HELPS** - The gift of helps is the divine strength or ability to work in a supportive role for the accomplishment of tasks in Christian ministry. Mark 15:40-41; Acts 9:36; Romans 16:1-2; 1 Corinthians 12:28 *(All Teams)*
- H) HOSPITALITY** - The gift of hospitality is the divine strength or ability to create warm, welcoming environments for others in places such as your home, office, or church. Acts 16:14-15; Romans 12:13, 16:23; Hebrews 13:1-2; 1 Peter 4:9 *(Students, Greeters, Next Steps, Kids Check-in, Parking, Host Team)*
- I) INTERCESSION** - The gift of intercession is the divine strength or ability to stand in the gap in prayer for someone, something, or someplace believing for profound results. Hebrews 7:25; Colossians 1:9-12, 4:12-13; James 5:14-16 *(Groups, Prayer, Worship)*
- J) KNOWLEDGE** - The gift of knowledge is the divine strength or ability to understand and to bring clarity to situations and circumstances often accompanied by a word from God. Acts 5:1-11; 1 Corinthians 12:8; Colossians 2:2-3 *(Groups, First Responders, Greeter, Usher)*
- K) LEADERSHIP** - The gift of leadership is the divine strength or ability to influence people at their level while directing and focusing them on the big picture, vision, or idea. Romans 12:8; 1 Timothy 3:1-13, 5:17; Hebrews 13:17
(All Teams)
- L) MERCY** - The gift of mercy is the divine strength or ability to feel empathy and to care for those who are hurting in any way. Matthew 9:35-36; Mark 9:41; Romans 12:8; 1 Thessalonians 5:14 *(Groups, Kids, Students, Missions, Safety Team)*
- M) MISSIONARY** - The missionary gift is the divine strength or ability to reach others outside of your culture and nationality, while in most cases living in that culture or nation. Acts 8:4, 13:2-3, 22:21; Romans 10:15
(Groups, Missions)

N) PASTOR/SHEPHERD - The gift of pastor/shepherd is the divine strength or ability to care for the personal needs of others by nurturing and mending life issues. John 10:1-18; Ephesians 4:11-14; 1 Timothy 3:1-7; 1 Peter 5:1-3
(Groups, Kids, Students, Next Steps, Host Team)

O) SERVICE - The gift of serving is the divine strength or ability to do small or great tasks in working for the overall good of the body of Christ. Acts 6:1-7; Romans 12:7; Galatians 6:10; 1 Timothy 1:16-18; Titus 3:14
(Admin, Kids, Students, Coffee, Missions, Set Up/Tear Down, Parking, Portable)

P) TEACHING - The gift of teaching is the divine strength or ability to study and learn from the Scriptures primarily to bring understanding and growth to other Christians. Acts 18:24-28, 20:20-21; 1 Corinthians 12:28; Ephesians 4:11-14 (Groups, Kids)

Q) WISDOM - The gift of wisdom is the divine strength or ability to apply the truths of Scripture in a practical way, producing a fruitful outcome and the character of Jesus Christ. Acts 6:3,10; 1 Corinthians 2:6-13, 12:8
(Groups, Missions, Worship,)
