Today, as we close out this week – it’s all about Holy Spirit!

“But I tell you the truth, it is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper (Comforter, Advocate, Intercessor—Counselor, Strengthener, Standby) will not come to you; but if I go, I will send Him (the Holy Spirit) to you [to be in close fellowship with you].” John 16:7 AMP

“... the Spirit of Truth, whom the world cannot receive [and take to its heart] because it does not see Him or know Him, but you know Him because He (the Holy Spirit) remains with you continually and will be in you.” John 14:17 AMP

This weekend, Pastor Jimmy Evans gave us four ways to receive and relate to Holy Spirit:

1. **As a free gift received by faith:** We never have to deserve Him. All that He is, and all the grace He empowers us with is all free if we just ask Him.
2. **As a person:** He is a person! He speaks, He feels, and He has things to say!

3. **As God:** He is fully God – omnipresent and never gone from us. We can trust Him fully!
4. **Every day and concerning everything in your life:** He’s ever patient and present. We can ask Him for anything and everything that we need. We can never drive Him away.

“Part of the empowering grace we have as believers is to wake up every day and say, ‘good morning Holy Spirit.’” – Pastor Jimmy Evans
