Jesus' Measure of Success

Mark 12:30-31 (TPT)

"The most important of all the commandments is this: 'The Lord Yahweh, our God, is one!' You are to love the Lord Yahweh, your God, with every passion of your heart, with all the energy of your being, with every thought that is within you, and with all your strength. This is the great and supreme commandment. And the second is this: 'You must love your neighbor in the same way you love yourself.'"

You are called to love and serve everybody - your neighbors, the people you work with, the people you go to school with, the people you see at the grocery store - all the people you encounter throughout your day. Success does not come from your own fulfillment, but from loving God and loving and serving others.

Activation - Actively Love God and Love Others

Mark 12:33-34

"It's the commandment to constantly love God with every passion of your heart, with your every thought, and with all your strength—and to love your neighbor in the same way as you love yourself." When Jesus noticed how thoughtfully and sincerely the man answered, he said to him, "You're not far from the reality of God's kingdom realm."

Jesus measures your success by how you love and serve others! When you shift from serving self to serving others, you step into God's kingdom realm where there is fullness of provision, protection, joy, satisfaction, fulfillment - everything that you are really looking for and cannot truly find outside of the Kingdom of God.
