When we are faithful with the little things – our attitude in the morning, our diligence in meeting Jesus in Scripture every day, our reactions in unfair circumstances – only then might we be trusted with more. When we recognize the authority we have as members of God's Church, it should change our everyday interactions. You have the authority given to you by the King of kings everywhere you go.

In your prayer today, ask God to reveal any areas where you can be more like him. Ask and listen as he reveals to you his heart for your friends, coworkers, and family – and how you can partner with him on a Kingdom mission.
