Hobie Alter launched his company in 1950 in his parents' garage, handcrafting a surfboard and launching his dreams. Over the past 75 years, the late Hobie Alter built his reputation on a relentless focus on quality and innovation, holding more than 20 revolutionary patents that showcase his commitment to advancing watercraft design. From pioneering pedal-driven kayaks to continually refining performance and comfort, Hobie products embody ingenuity and craftsmanship, delivering reliable experiences for every adventure on the water.
