New Life for Venture

NEW LIFE for Venture encompasses all the typical efforts that comprise our regular ministry activities. These efforts, however, are anything but "typical" as we aim to provide avenues for individuals to seek Jesus at Venture. In all, we plan to invest \$4.25 million in our ongoing ministries during NEW LIFE.

Our fall ministry kicked off last month and introduced exciting new opportunities within our regular programming. In Next Gen Ministries, we expanded both Children's and Student Ministry offerings.



In Children's Ministry, we introduced the new 4:5 Diner, created specifically for 4th and 5th graders and offered during both the 9:30 and 11:00 services. In Student Ministry, we launched Elevate, a middle school worship experience for 6th–8th graders, on August 3. These additions are already making a meaningful impact by giving kids and students age-specific spaces to grow in their faith. NEW LIFE FOR NEXT GENERATIONS



Throughout the NEW LIFE season, we aim to invest \$1.1 million to ensure our children and students are set up to thrive as they become the next generation of leaders in the church.

A central goal of NEW LIFE was to significantly reduce Venture's debt—freeing future generations to pursue new ministry opportunities without the weight of past capital costs. In June, we were able to pay off this debt *completely*. This was made possible through the generosity of NEW LIFE giving combined with existing cash reserves. Thank you for your continued generosity as we work to replenish our funds and move forward with future vision initiatives in the years ahead.



NEW LIFE FOR OTHERS

We plan to invest \$1.65 million in local and global outreach efforts. In addition to our regular missionary and mission organizations support, we are planning to more than double the amount of funds utilized for outreach efforts.

On August 24, Venture set aside our usual Sunday programming for Venture Out. For the second year, we challenged everyone to worship through serving by partnering with local outreach organizations.

Nearly 500 people participated, serving among 33 organizations throughout our community. In addition, each organization received a financial gift from Venture. If you or your group are interested in
