How To Lead An Essentials Module With A Group

step
1

GATHER YOUR GROUP. Set a weekly time for 4 weeks that works for everyone. It's good, especially for musicians and ministry members, to gather in a venue that is warm, inviting, and conducive to relaxed discussion.

step
2

READ A STUDY SESSION. Everyone is given a digital or printed copy of the Essentials Course Study Book (for that module). Read that week's session either together (paragraph by paragraph taking turns), or before you get together.

step
3

WATCH A BRIEF VIDEO. The Discussion Starter videos, like the session in the Study Book, is designed to be brief, but powerful. Each video is designed to drop off a few big ideas, mapping with the content that was read. Repetition = retention.

4

DISCUSS THE CONTENT. There are study questions at the end of each session in the Study Book. After reading the session, and watching the Discussion Starter video, turn to those study questions and give everyone a turn to share something.
