Description:

Youth Radio is seeking a video instructor. The instructor will be responsible for teaching video production and social media in training classes for students ages 14-24. The ideal candidate will have a love of working with young people and video production.

This position holds oversight of the training for YR's video track as well as oversees the work of interns and Project Associates -peer youth educators -that teach for the program. Applicants with experience working with Bay Area youth from different backgrounds are encouraged to apply.

Responsibilities:

- Classroom instruction for Youth Radio's video track
- Teach the fundamentals of video production to a group of 5-12 young people
- Instruct fundamental editing tools using Premiere
- Instruct video production for social media
- Supervise team of peer youth educators
- Evaluate student and peer youth educator projects
- Adapt and facilitate curricula specific to youth teaching cohort
- Incorporate media literacy into video curriculum
- Maintain classroom and building rules and a safe a professional learning/working environment
- Model professionalism

- Video teaching experience in classroom or community settings with a minimum of 2 years of experience in the field
- Advanced editing skills using Adobe Premiere Pro and experience with After Effects, Photoshop and other Adobe CC software.
