


Distribution of Patients with Opioid Use Disorder Diagnoses by Age

Percent of all procedure codes by aggregate allowed amounts for opioid use disorder




- H0047: Alcohol and/or other drug abuse services, not otherwise specified (avg. allowed amount: \$821)
- 99214: Established patient office or other outpatient visit with moderate level of decision making; if using time, 30 minutes or more (avg. allowed amount: \$126)
- G2067: Medication-assisted treatment, methadone, weekly bundle (avg. allowed amount: \$228)
- H0018: Behavioral health short-term residential treatment program, no room and board, per diem (avg. allowed amount: \$1.124)
- H0020: Methadone administration and/or service (avg. allowed amount: \$50)




Patients with Opioid Use Disorder Diagnoses per 100,000 Patients
