


Distribution of Patients with Opioid Use Disorder Diagnoses by Age

Percent of all procedure codes by aggregate allowed amounts for opioid use disorder




- H0015: Intensive outpatient treatment for alcohol and/or drugs, at least 3 days/week (avg. allowed amount: \$445)
- H0035: Mental health partial hospitalization, treatment, less than 24 hours (avg. allowed amount: \$715)
- G2067: Medication-assisted treatment, methadone, weekly bundle (avg. allowed amount: \$228)
- G2087: Office-based treatment for opioid use disorder, individual and group, 60 minutes in subsequent month (avg. allowed amount: \$342)
- S0201: Partial hospitalization services, less than 24 hours, per day (avg. allowed amount: \$679)




Patients with Opioid Use Disorder Diagnoses per 100,000 Patients
