Robust Database

FAIR Health's database contains data from two sources:

- Commercial medical and dental claims data
 - The nation's largest collection of commercial healthcare claims data, including claim records from 2002 to the present
 - Data from more than 75 payors and administrators who insure or process claims for both fully insured and self-insured plans
 - New data added monthly; about four billion additional claim records per year
 - Includes approximately 150 million covered lives in longitudinal dataset
- Medicare claims data
 - FAIR Health certified by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) as a Qualified Entity
 - Receives all Medicare Parts A, B and D claims data for all 50 states and Washington, DC
 - Claims from 2013 to present, representing the experience of all individuals enrolled in traditional Medicare
 - New Parts A and B data received quarterly; Part D data added annually

Geographic Specificity

- 493 geozips covering all 50 states; Washington, DC; Puerto Rico; and the US Virgin Islands

- Standard FH® Benchmarks modules—nationwide FH® Charge Benchmarks and FH® Allowed Benchmarks by category (e.g., medical, dental, facility), geography and percentiles
- FH® Medicare GapFill PLUS—includes CMS fees and fills gaps in the CMS fee schedule with values developed by applying to FAIR Health data the scale used by CMS for Medicare fees
