Topsy-Turvy Appliqué Project

Topsy-Turvy (reverse) Appliqué can be used for many different projects - wearables, home-dec, quilting, purses, totes, children's clothing, really almost anything that we sew. From ancient tribes that used reverse appliqué for their "molas", to today's use in computerized embroidery... the possibilities are endless.

Reverse appliqué used in computerized embroidery on knits, creates a design that is soft and retains the hand of the knit, but still offers a lot of dimension and color resulting from the layering of the fabrics, without the stiff result that comes from a high-stitch-count design.

It can be used on knits, soft, thin leathers or suedes, denim, fleece, minkie fur, and more. With the right stabilizers, and a temporary spray adhesive, it is easy and fun!

Supply List for Mug-Rug

- (1) 8" x 10" feature design fabric that will show through the top fabric for each Mug-Rug
- (1) 8" x 10" coordinating top fabric
- (1) 8" x 10" backing fabric (this can be a different coordinating fabric, or the same as either of the two fabrics you've already chosen.
- Sulky Super Solvy Water Soluble Stabilizer - (1) 8" x 10" piece for each Mug-Rug
- Sulky Fuse 'n Stitch Stabilizer - 8" x 10" piece for each Mug-Rug
- Sulky KK 2000™ Temporary Spray Adhesive
- Sulky 30 wt. Cotton Blendables® in a color to coordinate with top fabric
- Sharpie® Extra Fine-Line, Permanent-Ink
- Marker or FriXion™ Marker
- 14/90 Topstitch Needle
- 1/4" Foot
- Open-Toe Appliqué Foot
- Duck-Bill Appliqué Scissors
- Cutting Mat, Rotary Cutter and Ruler
- *Optional:* Small-blade, sharp scissors

Supply List for Topsy-Turvy Appliqué on Knits (Optional Bonus Projects)

- (1) Feature Design Knit Fabric that will show through the top fabric
- (1) Coordinating Knit top fabric
- Sulky Soft 'n Sheer Cut-Away Stabilizer (for stitching by machine) OR... Sulky Tender Touch Iron-on Stabilizer (for stitching by hand)
- Sulky Totally Stable Iron-On Stabilizer (by machine)
- Sulky KK 2000™ Temporary Spray Adhesive
- Sulky 12 wt. Solid Color Cottons (by hand) in a color or colors to coordinate with the top fabric OR...
- Sulky 12 wt. or 30 wt. Solid Color Cottons or Cotton Blendables® (by machine) in a color or colors to coordinate with the top fabric
- 14/90 (for 30 wt.) or 16/100 Topstitch Needle (for 12 wt.)

Silk Dupioni Appliquéd Flower Pillow Project

Silk Singed-edge appliqué and fringed-edged flowers and leaves make this a one-of-a-kind designer pillow. Be fearless using scrumptious Silk Dupioni in a new way!

Supply List

- 1/2 yd. Beige Silk Dupioni
Note: Silk Dupioni is expensive, but you will not get the same results using any other fabric. Go for it! You will fall in love with this elegant fabric.
- Fat Quarter of Green Silk Dupioni for leaves and stems - cut (4) - 1/2" BIAS strips for stems - save the remainder for the leaves
- (4) - 4" squares of Lt. Peach Silk Dupioni (or cream)
- (2) - 3" squares of Dk. Peach Silk Dupioni (or cocoa)
- (1) 18" square of Cotton Batting
- Sulky 40 wt. Rayon Thread to match beige silk
- Sulky 40 wt. Rayon to match green leaves
- Sulky KK 2000™ Temporary Spray Adhesive
- 2 yards (x 20") - (two 1-yd. packages will work) of Sulky Tender Touch™ Stabilizer
- 1 large bag of loose pillow stuffing (PolyFil™)
- 1/4" Clover™ Bias Maker
- 2-1/2 yds. Decorative Cording
- Soft vegetable brush to aid with the fringing of the leaves
- Steam-a-Seam2™ 1/4" Fusible Web Tape
- FriXion™ Pen or Light Chalk Marker
- Zipper Foot or Cording/Piping Foot Damp cloth to control burn
- Pressing Cloth (muslin will work)
- Rotary Cutter, Mat and Ruler with 45° Angle
- *Optional:* Self-Standing Smokeless Candle
- *Optional:* Duck-Billed Appliqué Scissors
- *Optional:* 16-18 Clover (Red) Wonder Clips
- *Optional:* 1 sheet of Sulky Sticky Fabri-Solvay or Sticky+ (for leaf templates)

Square Dance Applique Project

This will be one of the most creative and versatile appliqué projects that you will ever do. Depending on your color choices and theme, you can create one-of-a-kind looks using just small pieces of your favorite fabric. It's easy, fast and fun to do. All you need is a simple decorative stitch on a sewing machine, Sulky Thread and Sulky Stabilizers, a sweatshirt, scraps of fabric and an afternoon.

Add doo-dads, rubber stamps, couched yarns, and computerized embroideries. The sky's the limit!

- Sulky 30 wt. Blendables®, or Sulky Rayons to coordinate with fabrics chosen
- Sulky Polyester Invisible Thread for the bobbin (or Sulky Bobbin Thread or Sulky Prewounds)
- Sulky KK 2000™ Temporary Spray Adhesive
- Roll or 1 yd. packages of Sulky Totally Stable™, Tender Touch™ and Soft 'n Sheer™ Stabilizers
- Sulky Iron-on Transfer Pen (Brown or Black or a color that works with your base fabric or garment)
- Size 14/90 Topstitch Needle
- Open-toe Appliqué Foot
- Steam-A-Seam2 Lite™
- An Over-Sized Sweatshirt in medium color
- 4-7 coordinating fabrics and motifs

Marvelous Meandering Woven Table Runner Project

In its broadest sense, an appliqué is a smaller ornament or device applied to another surface. The term is borrowed from French and, in this context, means "applied" or "thing that has been applied". Appliqué is a surface pattern that is used to decorate an aspect of a garment or product.

So... Ellen's woven table runner is indeed an appliqué process. Enjoy!

- 1/2 yd. lighter color Cotton Fabrics for weaving
- 1/2 yd. darker color Cotton Fabrics for weaving
- 1/2 yd. Coordinating Cotton Fabric for borders
- 1/2 yd. Fabric for Backing
- 1/3 yd. Coordinating Fabric for Binding
- Sulky Tear-Easy™ Stabilizer - (2) 1- yd. packs
- Sulky Cut Away Plus™ Stabilizer - (2) 1 yd. packs

Zentangles® 3-D Appliqué Flower and 9-Patch Pillow Project

We suggest that you start out with the flower pin and if this turns out to be the new love-of-your-life, then you'll jump right into the nine-patch pillow! Of course, a much simpler free-motion design could be used for the pillow, too. Look for simple line drawings that abound in sewing books and online. But the Zentangles technique is so trendy and so much fun - doodling with your sewing machine - you'll be hooked.

Supply List for White Flower Only

- (1) 10" x 10" piece of white (good quality, closely woven) cotton fabric
- (1) 10" x 10" piece of black and white cotton fabric for backing
- (2) 10" x 10" piece of Warm and Natural® Cotton Batting
- (1) 10" x 10" piece of Sulky Soft 'n Sheer Extra™ Iron-On Stabilizer
- (1) 8-1/2" x 11" piece of Sticky Fabri-Solvay™ (pre-cut pieces come in package #475-02)
- 1 Decorative 3/4" button for center of each Flower
- Sulky 60 wt. PolyLite™ #972-1005 Black
- *Optional: Super Magnet (set) to attach flower to pillow or chosen project*
- *Optional: Sulky Polyester Clear Invisible Thread to sew petals together*

NOTE: For the Black Flower: Use black fabric, black batting, and you can use the Black Soft 'n Sheer™ and adhere it with KK 2000™ Temporary Spray Adhesive if you want, since there is no black Soft 'n Sheer Extra (fusible).

Supply List for Pillow Only

- 2/3 yd. white (good quality, closely woven) cotton fabric
- Fat quarter or 1/4 yd. of black fabric
- 1 yd. white background with black print cotton fabric (Prairie Points and Backing)
- 1/4 yd. black background with white print cotton fabric (Prairie Points)
- Another 1/4 yd. black background with white print (different from Prairie Point fabric) for Sashing around 9 patch
- 6" to 8" Thin German Wooden Machine Embroidery Hoop

- (2) 8-1/2" x 11" pieces of Sticky Fabri-Solvay™ (pre-cut pieces come in package #475-02)
- Sulky PolyLite 60 wt. #972-1005 Black
- (4) 10" x 10" pieces of Sulky Soft 'n Sheer Extra™ Iron-On Stabilizer
- Black sewing thread
- Spray Starch
- Pillow Form or muslin and PolyFil™ to make your own pillow form
