We have also added some Designer Yarns (very limited supplies) and Chenille Blooming Bias in Natural. (See page 9 for more info.)

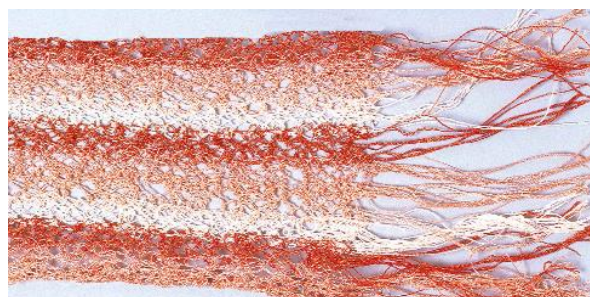

**#1 – Decorative-Stitched, Machine-Fed,
Non-Grid Thread Lace Scarf**



- [8" roll or 1 yd. pack of Sulky Ultra Solvy™ Water Soluble Stabilizer](#)
- Sulky 40 wt. Rayon Thread #942-2201 OR Baby Blue/Pink/Mint or #942-2202 Mint Greens/Pinks
Or...color(s) of your choice
(Or Sulky 30 wt. Cotton Blendables)
- [80/12 Organ®](#) or Schmetz® Embroidery or Topstitch Needle ([90/14 Topstitch](#) for 30 wt. Cotton Thread)
- Water Soluble or Permanent Ink Marker
- 24" Quilter's Ruler
- General Sewing Supplies
- Open-Toe Appliqué Foot (optional, but provides better visibility)
- General Sewing Supplies

**#2 – Fringed Decorative-Stitched, Machine-Fed, Non-Grid, Striped
Thread Lace Scarf**



- [8" roll or 1 yd. pack of Sulky Ultra Solvy™ Water Soluble Stabilizer](#)
- Sulky 40 wt. [Poly Deco™](#) Thread in 4 shades:
#962-1021 Maple
#962-1259 Salmon Peach
#962-1019 Peach
#962-1071 Pastel Peach
(Or Sulky 40 wt. Rayon Thread could be used, too.)
Or...color(s) of your choice. You could use 2, 3 or more different colors.
- [80/12 Organ®](#) or Schmetz® Embroidery or Topstitch Needle
- Open-Toe Appliqué Foot (optional)
- Water Soluble or Permanent Ink Marker
- 24" Quilter's Ruler
- General Sewing Supplies

**#3 - Decorative Stitched, Machine-Fed,
Ribbon Scarf or Shawl**

- 8" roll of Sulky Sticky Fabri-Solvy™ Water Soluble Stabilizer (Or a wider 12" roll if you want a shawl or wider scarf.)
Option: You could also use Sulky Ultra Solvy for this scarf, too.
- Matching size roll (or 1 yd. pack) of Sulky Solvy (the lightest weight Solvy) for a topper
- Sulky 40 wt. Rayon Thread or Sulky 30 wt. Cotton or Cotton Blendables® to coordinate with your ribbons (same or matching thread top and bobbin)
- Sulky Holoshimmer™ Metallic Thread or Sulky Clear Polyester Invisible Thread for couching the narrow ribbon
- 1" to 2" wide Sheer Poly-Blend Ribbon X the length of scarf/shawl X the desired width. (For instance, a 36" x 10" scarf would require about 5 yards of 2" wide ribbon.)

NOTE: Ellen used 1-1/2" ribbon, and she used 5 rows (about 7-1/2" finished width), Ribbon Floss (multi-color ribbon) or a thin to medium weight yarn to coordinate with other ribbons and trims.

She used about 1 yd. of this narrow ribbon every 6 inches of length of the scarf. But this is very arbitrary and you can use as much or as little as you find appealing to you.

- 80/12 Organ® or Schmetz® Embroidery or Topstitch Needle for the 40 wt. thread OR...
- 90/14 Organ® or Schmetz® Topstitch Needle for 30 wt. Cottons
- Optional: Beaded trim to coordinate with ribbons for both short ends (this gives it a nice weight to help it drape)
- Ribbon foot, couching foot, or open-toe appliqué foot; and edge foot (edge foot is optional)
- Quilting Guide (optional)
- Water Soluble or Permanent Ink Marker
- General Sewing Supplies

#4 – Gridded, Free-Motion Thread Lace Scarf



- 8" or 12" roll of Sulky Ultra Solvy™ Water Soluble Stabilizer
- 2 or 3 different colors of compatible Sulky 30 wt. Solid Color Cotton Threads (We used: 733-0580 Mint Julep, 733-1230 Dk. Teal, and some 733-1189 Dk. Chestnut for highlights.) 12 wt. Cottons could be used, too, if your machine likes the heavier threads. (The 12 wt, prefix is 713-XXXX.)

OR...use Sulky Cotton Blendables® which take all the guess-work out of choosing colors.

- Organ® or Schmetz® 90/14 Topstitch Needle for Sulky 30 wt. Cotton Thread or 30 wt. Cotton Blendables®
 - 100/16 Organ® or Schmetz® Topstitch Needle for Sulky 12 wt. Cotton Blendables
- (HINT: If you want to use the heavier 12 wt. on the top, choose the matching 30 wt. for the bobbin – 12 wt. is too heavy for the bobbin. Remember, you see both sides of the scarf.)*
- Water Soluble or Fine-Line Permanent-Ink Marker
 - 24" Quilter's Ruler
 - Open-Toe Applique Foot (optional, but provides better visibility)
 - Spring-Loaded, Free-Motion, Open-Toe Foot (**Important!**)
 - General Sewing Supplies

#5 – Evelyn’s Delicate Thread Lace Scarf



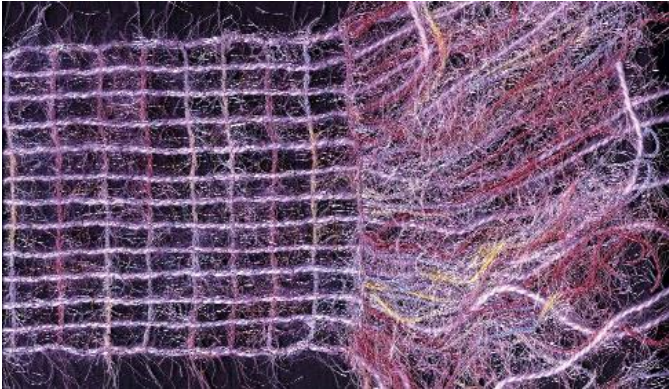
- 8” or 12” roll of Sulky Ultra Solvy Water Soluble Stabilizer
- 2 or 3 or more different colors of compatible Sulky 40 wt. Rayon Threads (solids or multi-colors)
2 SPOOLS EACH (because you will be running to threads through the needle, so you need two spools)
- Organ® or Schmetz® 90/14 Topstitch Needle
- Water Soluble or Fine-Line Permanent Ink Marker;
or Crayola Colored Wash-Away Markers (optional)
- 24” Quilter’s Ruler
- Open-Toe Appliqué Foot
- Spring-Loaded, Open-Toe, Free-Motion Foot (Important!)
- General Sewing Supplies

#6 – Combo Gridded Yarn and Thread Scarf



- 8” or 12” roll of Sulky Ultra Solvy™ Water Soluble Stabilizer
- Sulky 40 wt. Variegated or Multi-Color Rayon Thread
(You could also use Sulky 30 wt. Cotton Blendables® in a color that coordinates with your chosen yarn.)
- Sulky Clear Polyester Invisible Thread (Smoke Invisible if you are using VERY dark yarn)
- 80/12 Organ® or Schmetz® Topstitch Needle for 40 wt. Rayon or Invisible Threads
- Organ® or Schmetz® 90/14 Topstitch Needle for Sulky 30 wt. Cotton Thread or 30 wt. Cotton Blendables®
- Yarns of choice. Medium or lightweight yarns work best. (Minimum of 30 yards)
- Water Soluble or Fine-Line Permanent-Ink Marker
- 24” Quilter’s Ruler
- Beading or Cording Foot (best); or Open-Toe Appliqué Foot
- General Sewing Supplies

#7 – Gridded, Multi-Yarn and Thread Lace Scarf



- 8” roll of Sulky Ultra Solvy Water Soluble Stabilizer
- 2 or 3 different colors of compatible Sulky 30 wt. or 12 wt. Solid Color or Blendables® Cotton Threads; and/or Rayons; and/or Metallics.
- Sulky Polyester Invisible Thread (for couching yarns - but other matching threads could be used, too.)
- Organ® or Schemtz® 90/14 Topstitch for Needle for Sulky 30 wt. Cotton or Cotton Blendables.
- 100/16 Organ® or Schmetz® Topstitch Needle for Sulky 12 wt. Cotton or Cotton Blendables®
(HINT: If you want to use the heavier 12 wt. Cotton or Blendables on the top, choose the matching 30 wt. for the bobbin.)
- Yarns of choice: Medium or Lightweight yarns work best. You can use two, three, or more yarns. (Total About 30 yards.)
- Water Soluble Marker or Fine-Line Permanent-Ink Marker.
- 24” Quilter’s Ruler
- Beading or Cording Foot (best); or Open-Toe Applique Foot
- General Sewing Supplies

#8 – Chenille-It™ Scarf or Shawl



- 8” roll of Sulky Fabri-Solvy Water Soluble Stabilizer (or a 12” or 20” roll if you want a shawl or wider scarf.)
 - Cotton+Steel® Thread by Sulky (or other quality sewing thread) to match the chenille color you choose available at independent stores or online
 - “Chenille-It™ Blooming Bias” (1 or 2) 40-yd rolls of 5/8” wide (off-white #2-36 Natural, or color of your choice) [Natural color](#) available at Sulky other colors at www.fauxchenille.com
- Remember - if you make a scarf larger than ours 7” x 45”, you may need more Chenille.
- 80/12 Organ® or Schemtz® Universal Needle
 - Open-Toe or Closed-Toe Appliqué Foot
 - Water Soluble Marker
 - Quilter’s Ruler 24” ruler
 - Masking or Painter’s Tape
 - Tsukineko™ Fabric Dye Pens (optional - for coloring chenille if desired)
 - General Sewing Supplies

#9 – Decorative-Stitched, Non-Grid, Machine-Fed, Textured Yarn Scarf with Popcorn Fringe



- 8" roll of Sulky Ultra Solvy™ Water Soluble Stabilizer (or a wider roll if you want a shawl or wider scarf.)
- Sulky 40 wt. Rayon Thread or Sulky 30 wt. Cotton or Cotton Blendables® to coordinate with your yarns (same or matching thread top and bobbin)
- Sulky Holoshimmer™ Metallic Thread or Sulky Clear Polyester Invisible Thread for couching (optional)
OR...50 wt. Cotton+Steel 50 wt. Thread by Sulky
- 4 or 5 different textured yarns – matching or coordinating or contrasting, or mix and match - bumpy yarns, yarns that change thicknesses, eyelash (hairy) yarns, all add a lot of dimension and interest
- 90/14 Organ® or Schmetz Topstitch Needle
- Beading foot, or couching foot - sometimes called a braiding foot or a piping foot (depending on the size of your yarns)
- Zipper Foot (Relax! - no zipper used)
- Water Soluble or Permanent Ink Marker
- General Sewing Supplies

#10 – Mortitia Scarf or Shawl Twisted Fabric and Magical Threads



- 8" roll of Sulky Ultra Solvy™ Water Soluble Stabilizer (or a wider roll if you want a shawl or wider scarf.)
- Sulky 40 wt. Rayon Thread or Sulky 30 wt. Cotton or Cotton Blendables® to coordinate with your fabrics (same or matching thread top and bobbin)
- 80/12 Schmetz® Embroidery or Topstitch Needle for the 40 wt. thread
OR
- 90/14 Schmetz® Topstitch Needle for 30 wt. Cottons or Cotton Blendables®
- Open-toe or closed-toe appliqué foot
- 1 yd. (42" - 45" wide) of a quality Batik fabric (dyed through on both sides)
OR
- 1 yd. (42" - 45" wide) Silk Dupioni
Note: Whatever fabric you choose, be sure that it is dyed-through (both sides look the same). You need the larger amount because you will be cutting strips on the bias.
- Water Soluble or Permanent Ink Marker
- Quilter's Ruler
- Rotary Cutter and Mat
- Bamboo Skewer or Purple Thang™ (optional)
- General Sewing Supplies

#11 – Gridded Waterfall Scarf



- 12" roll of Sulky Sticky Fabri-Solvy™ Water Soluble Stabilizer
- 12" roll of Sulky Solvy or 1 yd. pack
- Cotton+Steel 50 wt. Thread by Sulky to match the color cording you use (or Sulky 40 wt. Rayon could be used also)
- 80/12 Organ® or Schmetz® Universal Or Topstitch Needle
- Lightweight cording like rat-tail, or even gimp
- Assorted fat quarters of compatible Colors of Silk Dupioni - OR just one or two colors, whatever you choose OR our favorite: Batiks in charm packs (5" square) - you want the fabric to be the same on both sides.
- Extra Fine-Line, Permanent-Ink Marker
- 24" Quilter's Ruler
- Beading or Cording or Couching Foot (best); or Open-Toe Appliqué Foot
- General Sewing Supplies
- Beading or Cording or Couching Foot (best); or Open-Toe Appliqué Foot
- General Sewing Supplies

#12 – Free-Form Fiber Frenzy Scarf



- 8", 12" or 20" roll of Sulky Sticky Fabri-Solvy™ Water Soluble Stabilizer (Also available in a 1-yd. pack [folded] or 8-1/2" x 11" sheets for smaller projects. And, ultimately a 25 YD. BOLT (for when you are possessed by this technique).
- Matching size of Sulky Solvy® or Super Solvy™ Stabilizer for a topper
- Sulky KK 2000™ Temporary Spray Adhesive
- Sulky Polyester Invisible Thread (for couching yarns - but other matching threads could be used, too)

Needles:

- Organ® or Schmetz® 90/14 Topstitch Needle For Sulky 30 wt. Cotton Thread or 30 wt. Cotton Blendables®
- 100/16 Organ® or Schmetz® Topstitch Needle for Sulky 12 wt. Cotton or 30 wt. Cotton Blendables® (HINT: If you want to use the heavier 12 wt. on the top, choose the matching 30 wt. for the bobbin.)
- 80/12 Schmetz® Embroidery or Topstitch Needle for 40 wt. Rayon Threads

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Other:

- Yarns, fibers and threads of choice.
Medium or lightweight yarns work best.
But snips of fabric, threads, bold fibers, and more can be used.
- Water Soluble or Fine-Line Permanent Ink Marker
- Masking or Painter's Tape
- Clover Wonder Clips (optional)
- Open-Toe Appliqué Foot (optional)
- Spring-Loaded, Open-Toe Free-Motion Foot (Important)
- General Sewing Supplies

#13 – BONUS – NOT REQUIRED Baker's Dozen Bonus Scarf



- 12" roll of Sulky Sticky Fabri-Solvy™ Stabilizer - (1) 10" x 48" piece
- 1 yd. pack or 8" roll of Sulky Solvy® Water Soluble Stabilizer (1) 8" x 48" piece
Note: These stabilizer sizes will yield an approximate 9-1/2" x 48" scarf
- Sulky Holoshimmer™ Metallic Thread #6003 Lt. Gold (or color of your choice)
- Main Ribbon - 1-1/2" wide x 3-1/2 yds.
- "Confetti" Ribbons - 9 colors - 1-1/2" wide, 9" of each



HINT: You want to choose good quality sewing ribbons, not craft ribbons. They need to be washable and soft.

- 1/4" wide Steam-A-Seam2™ Fusible Web 4-6" (optional) or **Sulky Perfect Appliqué (new)**
- Organ® or Schmetz® 90/14 Metallic or Topstitch Needle
- Teflon® Foot (optional)
- Open-Toe Appliqué Foot (optional)
- Quilting Guide Bar
- 24" Quilter's Ruler with 45-degree line
- General Sewing Supplies
